Maidstone 5K & 10K Road Run

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER 2020

To allow the Maidstone 5K & 10K Road Run to take place, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on various roads in Maidstone.

Closures are planned for Sunday 8th March 2020 starting from 09:00 onwards, with roads re-opened as soon as it is safe to do so, and by no later than 12:30.

The following roads will be closed on a rolling basis as the race progresses, as detailed below.

Hubbards Lane, Boughton Monchelsea - between the junctions with Heath Road and Haste Hill Road

Haste Hill Road, Boughton Monchelsea - between the junctions with Hubbards Lane and Beresford Hill/Church Street.

Beresford Hill, Boughton Monchelsea - from the junction with Haste Hill Road and Church Street to the junction with The Quarries and Bottlescrew Hill.

Cliff Hill Road, Boughton Monchelsea - between the junction with Bottlescrew Hill and Cliff Hill.

Cliff Hill, Boughton Monchelsea - from the junction with Cliff Hill Road to Pested Bars Road.

Pested Bars Road, Boughton Monchelsea - from Cliff Hill Road to the junction with Joy Road.

Brishing Road, Boughton Monchelsea - from the roundabout that meets Brishing Lane to the junction with Back Lane.

The Quarries, Boughton Monchelsea - from the junction with Bottlescrew Hill and Beresford Hill to the junction with Old Tree Lane and Cliff Hill.

Old Tree Lane, Boughton Monchelsea - from the junction with The Quarries and Cliff Hill to the junction with Green Lane and Gandy's Lane.

Green Lane, Boughton Monchelsea - from the junction with Old Tree Lane to the junction with Church Street.

Church Street, Boughton Monchelsea - from the junction with Beresford Hill to the junction with Heath Road.

Loddington Lane, Boughton Monchelsea - from the junction with Heath Road to the junction with Butt Green Lane.

Butt Green Lane, Boughton Monchelsea - from the junction with Loddington Lane to the junction with Lower Farm Road and Church Hill.

Lower Farm Road, Boughton Monchelsea - from the junction with Butt Green Lane

and Church Hill to the junction with Chart Hill Road.

Chart Hill Road, Chart Sutton - from the junction with Lower Farm Road to the junction with Chart Road.

Forge Lane, Chart Sutton - from the junction with Chart Hill Road to the junction with Lucks Lane.

Lucks Lane, Chart Sutton - from the junction with Forge Lane to the junction with Chart Hill Road.

Green Lane, Chart Sutton - from the junction with Chart Hill Road to the Y Junction.

Chart Road, Chart Sutton - from the junction with Chart Hill Road to the junction with Church Road.

Church Road, Chart Sutton - from the junction with Chart Road to the junction with Warmlake Road.

Warmlake Road, Chart Sutton - from the junction with Church Road to Amber Lane.

Amber Lane, Chart Sutton - between Warmlake Road and Back Lane.

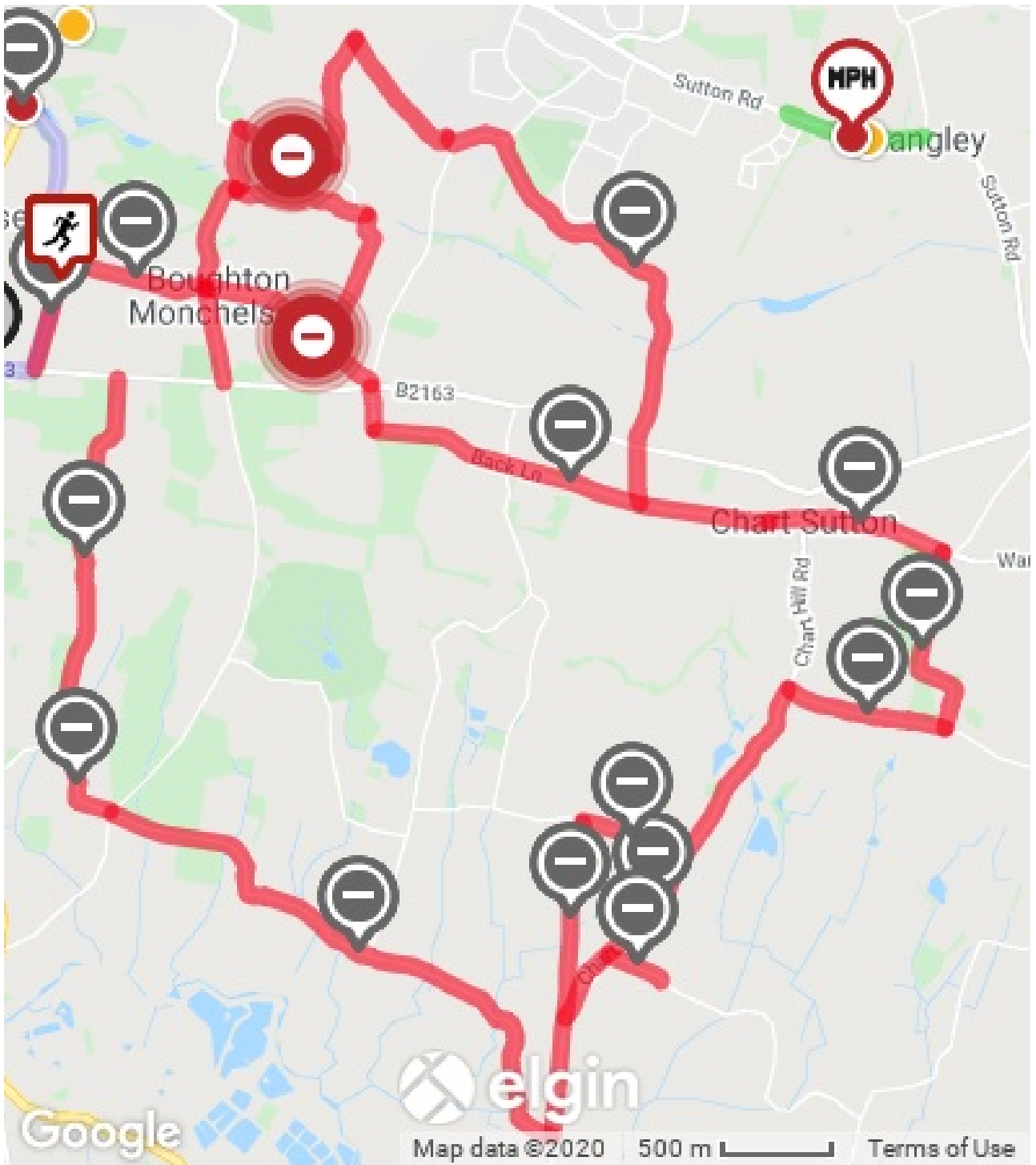
Back Lane, Boughton Monchelsea - between Amber Lane and Park Lane.

Park Lane, Boughton Monchelsea - from Back Lane to the junction with Heath Road.

Green Lane, Boughton Monchelsea - from the junction with Heath Road to the junction with Old Tree Lane and Gandy's Lane.

Marshalls will be in place to allow managed access for any residents affected when it is safe to do so, but there are likely to be delays and certain times when this is not possible for safety reasons.
